



Scope of practice. William L. RETAINER & BILLING POLICIES

Retainer	\$1,000 non-refundable retainer required before any work begins. Applied in full against the final invoice. Work will not commence until the retainer is received.
Invoicing	Invoices issued upon case milestone, or monthly for ongoing matters. Payment due within 30 days of invoice date.
